Dear Mr. Barnes:

Summa Silver Corp. (Summa) is sending this letter to request an extension to the minimal impact drilling permit no. CA027EM (the Permit) for the exploration drilling project near Mogollon in Catron County, New Mexico. For clarity the purpose of this letter is to request an extension for the Permit as it is currently approved and without any changes to the scope.

On February 28, 2024, Summa paused exploration drilling activities to allow for the uninterrupted completion of Mexican Spotted Owl monitoring by qualified biologists. The current permit term expires on September 8, 2024.

Summa respectfully requests a one-year extension to the Permit <u>as currently scoped and approved</u>. The extension will allow for Summa to complete additional exploration work in compliance with the original Permit, while moving forward with the permitting of the additional modifications in parallel. There will be no change in the amount of proposed disturbance within the permit area. All work will remain in compliance with the Permit.
